

Birding Guyana

This birding tour is suitable for both experienced Neotropical birders and those wanting to visit one of the last true wildernesses in South America. Some of the special and range-restricted birds we will look for include Rufous Crab-hawk, Harpy Eagle, Grey-winged Trumpeter, Painted Parakeet, Rufous-winged Ground-cuckoo, White-winged Potoo, Blood-coloured Woodpecker, White-bellied Piculet, Guianan Puffbird, Guianan Toucanet, Guianan Streaked-antwren, Guianan Warbling-antbird, Guianan Gnatcatcher, Guianan Cock-of-the-rock, Guianan Red-cotinga, Crimson Fruitcrow, Capuchinbird and Finsch's Euphonia.

For the more adventurous, there is an extension at the end of the tour to look for the spectacular Sun Parakeet and Red Siskin and the very poorly known Hoary-throated Spinetail and Rio Branco Antbird in a little explored area close to Brazil.

PRE-TOUR ITINERARY (OPTIONAL)

Friday - Arrive in Guyana. Transfer to Georgetown. Overnight at Cara Lodge.

Saturday - Pre-dawn Mahaica River birding tour. Optional Demerara Historical River Tour. Overnight at Cara Lodge. B

Sunday - Scheduled flight to Kaieteur Falls, the world's tallest single drop waterfall. Overnight at Cara Lodge. B

MAIN ITINERARY

Sunday - Arrive in Guyana. Transfer to Georgetown. Overnight at Cara Lodge.

Monday - Flight to Fair View Airstrip. Pick up and transfer to Iwokrama River Lodge. Explore the trails around the lodge with an Iwokrama Ranger. Evening river trip to spot wildlife. Overnight at the Iwokrama River Lodge. BLD

Tuesday - Dawn boat trip on the Essequibo River looking for birds and wildlife. Hike Turtle Mountain for incredible views across the forest canopy or boat trip to Stanley Lake to search for Giant River Otters and Black Caiman. Visit Kurupukari Falls to see the Amerindian petroglyphs (dependent on the water level). Overnight at the Iwokrama River Lodge. BLD

Wednesday - Explore the different trails along the river with an Iwokrama Ranger. Transfer from the Iwokrama River Lodge along the trail that is one of the best places to see the elusive Jaguar, to the Iwokrama Canopy Walkway and Atta Rainforest Lodge. Visit the Iwokrama Canopy Walkway and explore surrounding trails. Overnight at Atta Rainforest Lodge. BLD

Thursday - Visit the walkway before returning to the lodge for breakfast. Enjoy wildlife and birdwatching walks on the trails around the area. Return visits to the Canopy Walkway and night walks are also possible. Overnight at Atta Rainforest Lodge. BLD

Friday - Early morning at the canopy walkway and then return to the lodge for breakfast before departure. Transfer to the Guianan Cock-of-the-rock trail and then continue to the community-owned and operated Surama Eco Lodge. A local guide will escort you for a short walk on trails to observe the forest and bird life. After-dark walk to spot the Northern Tawny-bellied Screech-Owl, as well as Tropical Screech-Owl, Lesser Nighthawk, and White-tailed Nightjar. Overnight at Surama Eco-lodge. BLD

Saturday - Pre-dawn birding around the lodge looking to spot the Red-legged Tinamou, Painted Parakeet, Lilac-tailed Parrotlet, Rufous-throated Sapphire, Guianan Puffbird, Northern Slaty-antshrrike, Rufous-bellied Antwren. Afternoon Burro Burro River excursion. Optional tour to visit to the Harpy Eagle site. Overnight at Surama Eco-lodge. BLD

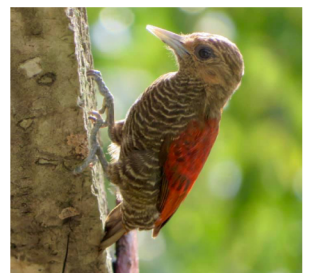
Sunday - Enjoy an early forest walk to look for wildlife and birds or relax around the lodge before breakfast and departure. Travel south through the savannah and the foothills of the Pakaraima Mountains with excellent opportunity for savannah birding. Boat transfer from Ginep Landing to Karanambu Lodge, wildlife spotting along the way. Late afternoon boat excursion for wildlife spotting and as dusk falls to the ponds to see the giant Victoria amazonica water lily bloom at dusk. On the return trip we will spotlight for Black Caiman and birds and creatures of the night. Overnight at Karanambu Lodge. BLD

Monday - Search the savannah for Giant Anteaters and then return for breakfast. Evening river excursion or explore the woodland patches or gallery forest along the river to look for Jacanas, Purple and Azure Gallinules, and Tiger Herons. Overnight at Karanambu Lodge. BLD

Tuesday - Early morning birding around the Lodge or take the opportunity to travel out onto the savannah to look for two hard to get species, the Bearded Tachuri and the Crested Doradito, and maybe even a Giant Anteater. Transfer by vehicle across the savannah to Lethem. Scheduled flight to Georgetown. Afternoon birdwatching in the Georgetown Botanical Gardens where, if we are lucky, we will have views of the Blood-coloured Woodpecker. Overnight at Cara Lodge. B

Wednesday - Pickup and transfer to the airport for your departing flight. B

POST-TOUR ITINERARY (OPTIONAL)

Tuesday - Take the arduous drive from Karanambu towards Karasabi to see the critically endangered Sun Parakeet. Transfer to Manari Ranch. Overnight at Manari Ranch. BLD

Wednesday - An extremely early start, traveling south of Lethem to look for the highly endangered Red Siskin, American Wood Stork, Buff-necked Ibis, White-tailed Hawk, Red-bellied Macaw, White-fringed Antwren, Yellow-bellied Elaenia and Red-breasted Blackbird. Return to Lethem. Overnight at Manari Ranch. BLD

Thursday - Today, we will focus on two birds which have seemingly always had restricted ranges, the Hoary-throated Spinetail and Rio Branco Antbird. During the trip, we are likely to encounter species such as Capped Heron, Muscovy Duck, Pale-legged Hornero and various hirundines while traveling. Transfer to Lethem for scheduled flight back to Georgetown. Overnight at Cara Lodge. BL

Friday - Pickup and transfer to the airport for your departing flight. B
